From RT 82 & 340 ... Follow RT 340 West, past Kings Highway School to the first crossroads. Turn left on to S. Sandy Hill Rd. Go 1/2 mile on the right #251.

From RT 10 & RT 30 ... Go North on RT 10 to the first crossroads. Turn right on to Beacon Light Road, go to stop sign, turn right on to Old Wilmington Rd. Immediately turn left on to S. Sandy Hill Rd. go 1/2 mile #251 on the left.

From RT 10 & RT 340 follow RT 340 E. pass blinking light, to the first road on the right. Turn right on to Old Wilmington Rd, go to first rd on the left, turn left on to S. Sandy Hill Rd. Go 1/2 mile # 251 on left.

Camp Details

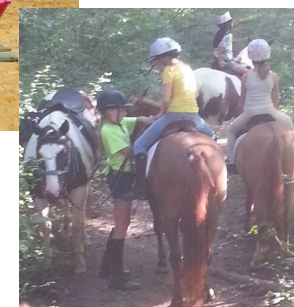
- For ages 9 and up.
